| Authorized Provided that : - Cargo is Accompanied by complete & appropriate documentation (Manifest, packing List & MSDS) - Cargo is Packaged & Stuffed according to IMDG Code Regulations - Container is marked with stickers etc accordingly to IMDG Code | ✓ |
| Unauthorized: - Transshipment and import activity of class 7 is not authorized. | ✗ |
| AUTHORISATION UNDER RESTRICTIONS: - Transit for class 7 is authorized under restrictions. No movement of the IMO container should be done onboard the vessel when at berth (even from cell to cell). - Transshipment and Import activity for class 1 and class 6 is authorized under restrictions. The forwarder must submit a request for authorization to APMT for transshipment and Import of any IMO container of class 1 (excluding class 1.4) and 6 prior loading from the departure port. Besides, the containers have to be discharged and transported outside the terminal upon discharge; the container shouldn't stay more than 24 hours on the Terminal whatsoever. Same rule applies for exports containers which are only allowed for gate in 24 hours before vessel berthing. | ● |
